

Opus and Carspect agree to cooperate to establish vehicle inspection in Sweden

During this spring, Opus Prodox AB (publ) announced that it had signed an agreement to establish vehicle inspection at Bilia's locations in Sweden. During the last six months, work on this project has been ongoing and has now led to a cooperation agreement with Carspect as the operator. In this new cooperation, Opus will be responsible for test equipment, installation, maintenance and calibration, while Carspect is the operator and runs the vehicle inspection stations under its own brand, with its own staff.

Carspect is the one of the new players in the market, that to date, has established the most stations in Sweden and now with this agreement, the network will be expanded further.

This cooperation has benefits for all parties and will commence in the Stockholm region at the beginning of next year, and then gradually expand to other parts of the country.
