Opus gets its largest order ever.

The order worth 6,6 MSEK is for supply of emission test equipment for schools in Poland.

During 2005 Opus Prodox AB together with their polish partners Tehand sp. z o.o. and Beissbarth Equipment Sp. z o. o. won a public tender for supply of modern test equipment to high schools in Poland. The tender was appealed in several courts but is now finally settled and the contract with the Ministry of Education is signed. The delivery contract includes several types of equipment and the total value is approx. 5 M EURO. Opus part of the contract is 6,6 MSEK. The deliveries will be started already in June and the complete order will be delivered within the third quarter in 2006.

The order, partially financed by EU funding, is a breakthrough for Opus on the Polish market within emission test equipment. Opus has already delivered equipment for EOBD testing to polish vehicle inspection stations and is market leader within this segment. This contract will also make the emission equipment well known on the market.

Now are we looking forward to continue our expansion in the east European countries, says Magnus Greko, Managing Director at Opus.
